

ATTENTION- RAIL STRIKES 25/26th MAY

Please be aware that there are rail strikes are happening on the 25th May, RMT will conduct a 24 hour rail strike that will affect rail services UK wide. The below details are what Greater Anglia and Cross Country Trains will be operating to and from Stansted Airport. This is subject to change and please log on to www.stanstedexpress.com for up to date information.

Monday 25 th May 2015	As a result of Network Rail Industrial Action, the following alterations will apply: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Normal Stansted Express Train service 06:00 – 14:00hrs ONLY• NO CROSS COUNTRY SERVICES
Tuesday 26 th May 2015	As a result of Network Rail Industrial Action, the following alterations will apply: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Stansted Express Train Service 07:30-18:30hrs ONLY• Half Hourly 12 car service• Train service calling Stansted Mountfitchet,, Bishops Stortford, Sawbridgeworth, Harlow Town, Broxbourne, Cheshunt and Tottenham Hale• NO CROSS COUNTRY SERVICES
Wednesday 27 th May 2015	Expected to be a normal service although some train services may be subject to cancellation due to train stock availability

IMPORTANT: There are no rail replacement bus services being provided

There are scheduled coach services available to passengers and staff for connections into London. These are:- National Express A6 - London Victoria, National Express A8 - Liverpool Street, National Express A9 – Stratford, Terravision A50/51 - Liverpool St & London Victoria, Terravision A52 – Stratford, easyBus- Old Street & Baker Street.

National Express also provides connections to Cambridge via the 727 service. Details of which can be found on www.nationalexpress.com Additional coaches are being introduced by our scheduled coach operators to increase services in and out of London to provide additional capacity on existing scheduled services.

Staff travelling in from Harlow and Bishops Stortford by train are advised to use existing local bus services as an alternative during the strike period.

Staff travelling from Tottenham Hale are advised to travel into Liverpool St or Stratford via London Underground and travel in by coach during the strike period.

Please note that Airport Travelcard is only accepted on the National Express services.

Staff are advised to leave additional time to travel to the Airport during the strike period to avoid reporting late for work.

Staff Car Park Shuttle Buses

Staff who are parking in Coopers End Car Park are reminded that as well as the Long Stay Shuttle Buses, there are other services available to transfer staff to the Terminal/Coach Station.
